- To experience a variety of themes and approaches to teaching number in the EYFS and Year 1

- To solve mathematical problems suitable for EYFS and Year 1.

Course information:

As the 2018-19 EYFS pilot draws to a close this summer and with the possible reduction of ELG in mathematics on the horizon, this course seeks to show how to support and develop young children's number sense.

During the morning, delegates will think about how they can to draw out number related concepts across a variety of common EYFS themes.
